A Catholic education is a challenging education. Saint Brigid of Kildare School lays a foundation for academic success that enables your child to flourish – now and in the future.

- Student achievement shows that our students are self-disciplined, motivated, responsible, and creative.
 - Our students typically score 30 points above national averages on the Terra Nova, a nationally recognized standardized test for students in grades 4, 6, and 8.
 - Our students score above diocesan averages on the Terra Nova.
 - Saint Brigid of Kildare alumni attending Bishop Watterson High School who took the trial Ohio Graduation Test in March of 2004 far surpassed statewide averages.
 - Saint Brigid of Kildare alumni attending Bishop Watterson High School earn college scholarships at a rate exceeding that of the Watterson student body as a whole.
 - Saint Brigid of Kildare alumni currently attend the most prestigious universities in the Midwest.
